



Visual Effects Training Program XXII

Creating the next generation of VFX artists in Scotland

[FixFX](#) are working on an exciting new Intern and Apprenticeship Programme to start fifteen new entrants on the journey to becoming skilled VFX compositors for film and tv productions.

The programme will comprise three stages over the course of a year. Kicking off with an intensive six week training course, then a three month internship and finally a mentored apprenticeship working as a junior artist.

Recruits will come from throughout Scotland and all training will be conducted remotely with recruits working from home. There will also be opportunities for the Interns/Apprentices to come together and visit FixFX at key points across the programme.

Training will be run by [Escape Studios](#) and FixFX. Recruits must be based in Scotland and 18 or over to apply.

Interns/Apprentices will be paid the Real Living Wage.

Applications are strongly encouraged from people who are traditionally under-represented in the industry or may have faced barriers to entry.

Including:

- Women
- Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic background
- LGBTQIA+
- D/deaf and/or Disabled
- Identify as being from a lower socio-economic background
- Have experience of being in the care system
- Carers
- Gaelic speakers
- Where English is not the main language
- Refugee and Migrant background
- Resident in Scotland within under-represented geographical areas whether a region, location or community
